MARCHING BAND AND COLOR GUARD

The Marching Band is the flagship ensemble of our program. The largest organization on campus, the very popular and highly visible marching Ganders perform at football games as well as several competitions during the marching season. The band is known for high quality performances, entertaining and unique shows.

Its members learn and embody excellent character, discipline, and professionalism in all aspects of performance. Marching Band is a part of the band program that functions mostly as an extracurricular activity, with rehearsals and performances taking place outside of school hours. Every student enrolled in a band class is automatically a member of the marching band

CONCERT BANDS

The Concert Bands are the cornerstone of our band program here at Lee High School. They meet during the school day and include the Wind Ensemble (5A varsity), Symphonic Band (5A non-varsity), and the Concert Band Advanced (5A subnon-varsity). Varying from year to year is the addition of a concert band and the applied music class. The band staff will always communicate when those classes are in effect.

JAZZ ENSEMBLE

Jazz Ensemble is an additional music class offered by the band department as an elective you can take in addition to your main band class. This ensemble allows students to experience a different style of music, and even potentially play a different instrument (such as piano, guitar, or bass) than the one they play in concert band.

WINTER GUARD

Winter Guard is an extracurricular visual performance ensemble that competes from January through April. This activity combines modern dance with flag, rifle, and saber choreography. Membership is open to anyone at Lee High School, with auditions in the late fall. Winter Guard typically practices 2-3 days a week after school, with competitions on Saturdays in the Texas Colorguard Circuit.
